Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU") is entered into 1ST of December 2023, by and between DIVYA JYOTI AYURVEDIC MEDICAL COLLEGE, with an address of DIVYA JYOTI AYURVEDIC MEDICAL COLLEGE, NIWARI ROAD, MODINAGAR-201204, and PATANJALI BHARTIYA AYURVIGYAN EVAM ANUSANDHAN SAMSTHAN, Haridwar with also individually referred to as "Party", and collectively "the Parties."

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to enter into an agreement for the Student and Faculty Exchange Programme and WHEREAS, the Parties desire to memorialize certain terms and conditions of their anticipated endeavor; NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

- Purpose and Scope.** The Parties intend for this MOU to provide the foundation and structure for any and all possibly anticipated binding agreement related to **Student and Faculty Exchange Programme**. This MOU should not establish or create any type of formal agreement or obligation. Instead, it is an agreement between the Parties to work together in such a manner to encourage an atmosphere of collaboration and alliance in the support of an effective and efficient partnership to establish and maintain objectives and commitments with regards to all matters related to the said Programme.

2. **Objectives.** The Parties agrees as follows:

- 2.1. The Parties shall work together in a cooperative and coordinated effort so as to bring about the achievement and fulfillment of the purpose of the MOU.
- 2.2. It is not the intent of this MOU to restrict the Parties to this Agreement from their involvement or participation with any other public or private individuals, agencies, or organizations.
- 2.3. The Parties shall mutually contribute and take part in any and all phases of the planning and development of Student and Faculty Exchange Programme to the fullest extent possible.
- 2.4. This MOU is not intended to create any rights, benefits, and/or trust responsibilities by or between the Parties.
- 2.5. The MOU shall in no way obligate either Party to supply funds to maintain and/or sustain the **Student and Faculty Exchange Programme.**

Term. This Agreement shall commence upon the Effective Date, as stated above, and will continue until 1st of December 2026.

3. **Termination.** This Agreement may be terminated at any time by either Party upon 7 days written notice to the other Party.

Representations and Warranties. Both Parties represent that they are fully authorized to enter into this Agreement. The performance and obligations of either Party will not violate or infringe upon the rights of any third-party or violate any other agreement between the Parties, individually, and any other person, organization, or business or any law or governmental regulation.

5. **Limitation of Liability.** Under no circumstances shall either party be liable to the other party or any third party for any damages resulting from any part of this agreement such as, but not limited to, loss of revenue or anticipated profit or lost business, costs of delay or failure of delivery, which are not related to or the direct result of a party's negligence or breach.

6. **Severability.** In the event any provision of this Agreement is deemed invalid or unenforceable, in whole or in part, that part shall be severed from the remainder of the Agreement and all other provisions should continue in full force and effect as valid and enforceable.

7. **Waiver.** The failure by either Party to exercise any right, power, or privilege under the terms of this Agreement will not be construed as a waiver of any subsequent or future exercise of that right, power, or privilege or the exercise of any other right, power, or privilege.

8. **Legal Fees.** In the event of a dispute resulting in legal action, the successful party will be entitled to its legal fees, including, but not limited to its attorneys' fees.

9. **Entire Agreement.** The Parties acknowledge and agree that this Agreement represents the entire agreement between the Parties. In the event that the Parties desire to change, add, or otherwise modify any terms, they shall do so in writing to be signed by both parties.

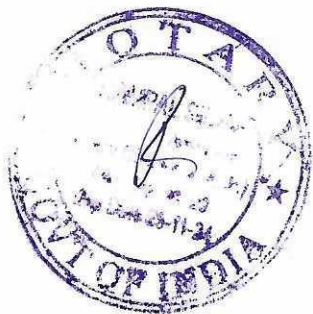

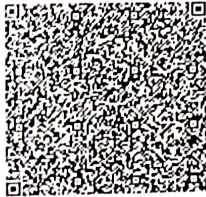

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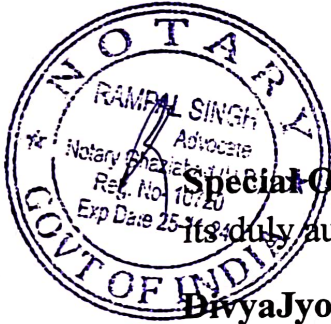


Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

WHEREAS

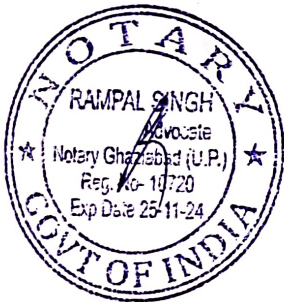
Both parties have entered this MoU with an objective to promote and help the cause 'Good General Health - Inclusion Revolution'.

- iii. To provide branding and recognition on the official website and application of SOB.

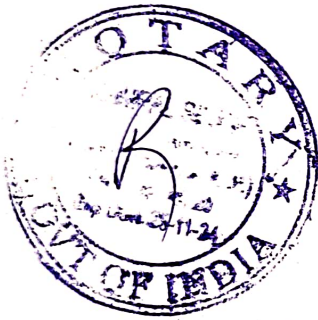
2. General Conditions

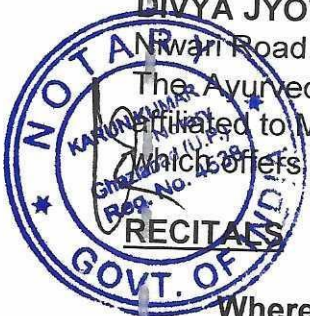
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and entered into this 24th Day of November, 2024

BETWEEN

The Ayurveda College is a self-financed institution, approved by NCISM and is affiliated to Maha Yogi Guru Gorakhnath Ayush University, Gorakhpur. The College, which offers a BAMS, is herein after called the party of the **SECOND PART**.



Whereas the Dharamshila Narayan Super speciality and **Divya Jyoti Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital** are willing to work together to offer joint programmes including, but not limited to educational and research programmes and also exchange of students and faculties and

Whereas **Divya Jyoti Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital** and Dharamshila Narayan Super speciality have agreed to offer suchh programmes on the terms and conditions contained here in below.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and "inconsideration of agree the mutual promises and understanding, the parties agree as follows:

1. **SCOPE OF THE MOU**

A. Exchange of Information

The two institutions will work to develop agreements or programs for exchanging academic, research and other educational materials.

B. Exchange of Students

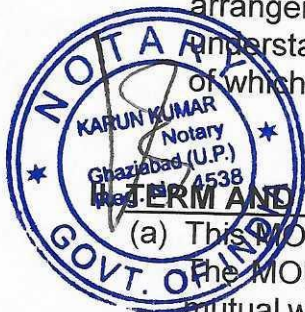
The parties will work to develop agreements and programs for Stewardship program in Oncology for **Divya Jyoti Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital** Interns under the Mentorship of Dr. Rinki Langeh. On mutual consent such as programs shall also be open for external candidates with a cost of participation as decided by both the parties.

C. Collaborative programs

Collaborative programs, seminars and research activities will be encouraged and supported where the mutual interests and expertise of both institutions maybe furthered. Faculty and program directors at both institutions should be encouraged to enter into contract with one another in order to further this objective.

D. Cooperation for Development Resource

The two institutions will explore avenues to develop financial resources to support educational activities sponsored under this Agreement, including joint grant proposals, In each of the above-mentioned areas of cooperation and any other areas in which the two institutions wish to cooperate, detailed arrangements can be developed through separate memoranda of understanding, exchange of letters, appendices or other written agreements, all of which must be signed in writing by both parties to be effective.



TERM AND TERMINATION

(a) This MOU shall remain in effect from the date of signing for a period of 3 years. The MOU may be extended or renewed for additional period of time upon the mutual written consent of the parties subject to such terms and conditions as the parties shall determine

ATTESTED

(b) If either party believes the stated purposes of this MOU are not being fulfilled, the other party shall be notified of the areas of concern in writing. Both parties shall attempt to resolve those concerns through common efforts. If no solution can be achieved, either party may terminate this MOU by providing written notification at least (2) two months in advance; provided, however, that such termination shall not affect the on-going programmes if any.

- (c) If the termination is for the other party's non-compliance with any material term of this MOU, the party desiring to terminate will contact the other party in writing and such party shall have thirty (30) days to correct the situation (cure period). If the situation (cure period).

If the situation is not corrected after the thirty (30) days cure period. The termination shall be effective immediately following the thirty (30) days cure period: provided, however, that such termination shall not take effect with respect to the on going programme if any.

- (d) The parties may immediately terminate this MOU in the event that there is a change in law, regulations or policy of the Government that are not in conformity with the terms and conditions of this MOU.

III. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In the case of any dispute that may arise in future shall be resolved through mutual consultation and discussion. All efforts shall be made by both the parties to iron out the difference, if any, and in the event of not being able to resolve the tangle, the issue may be resolved through Arbitration by the sole arbitrator to be mutually appointed by the parties.

IV. INDEPENDENT PARTIES

The parties are independent of the one another, Nothing in this MOU shall be constructed to create a partnership, joint venture, agency, or employment relationship between the parties. Neither party is authorized or empowered to act as agent for the other for any purpose and shall not behalf of the other enter into any contract, warranty, or representation as to any matter.

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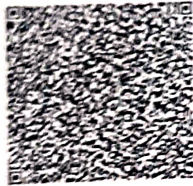

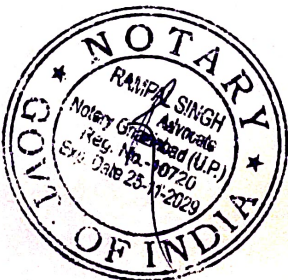

Vedic Medical Astrology Center, Bangkok, Thailand, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the subject or context thereof, be demand ti include and mean to its nominees, successors and permitted substitute or assigns) on **Second Party** either or both of which may be referred as a "Party" or the "Parties" respectively as the context demands.

Whereas,

A. The **DJAMC&H** and **Vedic Medical Astrology Center, Bangkok, Thailand**, desire to collaborate in the field of intra and interdisciplinary research, drug testing facilities, faculty and student exchange program for the mutual benefit by utilizing the expertise and infrastructure existing in both institutions.

B. Based on the strengths of the **DJAMC&H** and **Vedic Medical Astrology Center, Bangkok, Thailand**, the **DJAMC&H** is desirous of collaborating with **Vedic Medical Astrology Center, Bangkok, Thailand**, which would provide education/research program/ faculty, drug testing facilities, student exchange/academic programs for the mutual benefit by utilizing the expertise and infrastructure existing in both institutions.

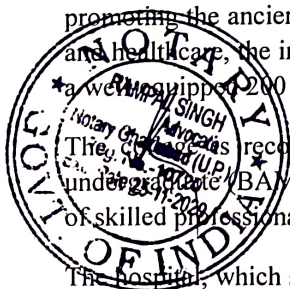
MoU is to establish hereby a formal understanding of cooperation which is intended to have further the research objectives of each institution and to promote better understanding between the faculty and students of **DJAMC&H** and the faculty and students of **Vedic Medical Astrology Center, Bangkok, Thailand**.

Vedic Medical Astrology Center, Bangkok, Thailand,

EAA is one of the Celebrated institutions in Europe and one of the largest and most pioneering Providers of Ayurvedic education. It was established in 2018 and Serving France and other countries with 4 years Syllabus and we promote Ayurveda along with other local institutions in Europe.

Under this Memorandum of Understanding, the two institutions will proceed to implement the following endeavors and exchanges of materials and personnel.

ARTICLE I: OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force, agree to strengthen, promote and develop co-operations in the field of Indian system of medicine (Ayurveda) and Inter Disciplinary Medicine between the two Institutions.

ARTICLE II: AREAS OF COOPERATION

Cooperation shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and the approval of the competent authority of DJAMC&H and Vedic Medical Astrology Center, Bangkok, Thailand, through such activities or programs as:

EXCHANGE PROGRAMS:

Faculty UG students and Interns will be exchanged from both Institutes for different programs like workshops, guest lectures, short time training courses, seminars, short term research programs. and project works etc. as agreed by both institutes from time to time.

Utilization of research facilities, Joint Research activities

- Faculty and students of both institutes will be allowed, with prior permission, to utilize the research facilities of the Institutes by prescribed nominal fee.
- Both institutions will facilitate the students & faculty by providing access to facilities, guidance of concerned faculty and research staff.
- Both will promote and facilitate inter-institutional, inter disciplinary research and collaborative research projects by faculty and students of the institutions. Short term research projects, summer research projects will be allowed.



Online meetings/On line Guest lectures

Innovative methods, Information Communication & technology will be used to have better interaction among faculty and students of Institutes through Online guest lectures, group interactions organized through Skype etc.

Research & Development

- Both institutes will work in this area of research & training, especially Drug Analysis Quality control & Standardization through organizing workshops, brain storming sessions, skill development programs, CME programs collaboratively.
- Facilitation for conduction of tests/analysis available in both institutes to each other.
- Submission of samples for analysis for mutual validation of test results.
- Promotion of research publications in the journals.
- The terms of such mutual cooperation and necessary budget for each specific program will be decided case by case basing upon mutual agreement.
- Each Institute will designate a Liaison Officer to develop and coordinate specific activities or programs.

ARTICLE III: FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

The financial arrangements to cover expenses for the identified research activities undertaken within the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually agreed upon by both the Parties on a case-by-case basis subject to availability of funds.

ARTICLE IV: PROTECTION OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

(a) The protection of intellectual property rights shall be enforced in conformity with the national laws, rules and regulations.

(b) Notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) above, the intellectual property rights in respect of any technological development, and any products and services development, carried

out:

(i) Jointly by the parties or research results obtained through the joint activity effort by the Parties, shall be jointly owned by the Parties in accordance with the terms to be mutually agreed upon; and

(ii) Solely and separately by the Party or the research results obtained through the sole and separate effort of the Party, shall be solely owned by the Party concerned.

(iii) The terms and conditions in the execution of the research projects shall be decided on case to case basis.

ARTICLE V: CONFIDENTIALITY

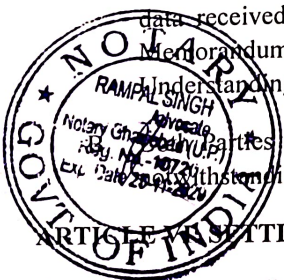
A. Each Party undertakes to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from, or supplied to, the other Party during the period of the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding or any other agreements made pursuant to this Memorandum of

Understanding:

The Parties agree that the provisions of this Article shall continue to be binding between the Parties notwithstanding the termination of this Memorandum of Understanding.

ARTICLE VI: SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provision of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiation between the Parties. In case, the dispute occurred between both the parties and if the same is not resolved through negotiation or by adopting amicable measures, in that case the matter will be settled through Arbitration and the Arbitrator will be appointed with the mutual consent of both the parties.



ARTICLE VII: ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

This understanding shall come into force and take effect from the date first written above and shall be valid for a period of FIVE (5) YEARS and may be renewed thereafter by the parties upon mutual consent.

This understanding may be terminated by either party by providing 90 (ninety) days written notice to the other party before the beginning of academic year, and the termination would be effective at the end of the notice period.

And the termination of the Understanding shall be on the understanding that students/ faculty who have already enrolled in any of the courses/ research programs as at the time of termination shall remain entitled to complete their respective courses/ research programs and be eligible to appear assessment conducted by the **DJAMC&H and Vedic Medical Astrology Center, Bangkok, Thailand**, conducted to obtain an award. The obligation of the parties shall continue to be in force during such period, notwithstanding any termination of the Understanding.

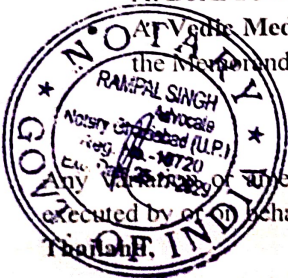
Now this MOU Witnesses as follows the Roles and Responsibilities of Either Party

- Institutes may provide minimal accommodation for students/faculty of other institute in their institute at nominal costs, based on availability.
- Students/ faculty have to pay the prescribed fee for the facilities utilized.
- Institutes have to facilitate for easy exchange programs and collaborative work. Administrative hurdles to be cleared at higher level by clear transparent methodology.
- Periodic meeting of co-ordinators will be arranged to have collaboration and co-operation among faculties of two institutes.
- Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.
- **DJAMC&H and Vedic Medical Astrology Center, Bangkok, Thailand**, will facilitate for collaborative activities in research and training. Both will arrange facilities for conducting activities including in-house and visiting members from academic institutes.
- **DJAMC&H and Vedic Medical Astrology Center, Bangkok, Thailand**, shall also arrange to appoint a Coordinator who shall be available at the center where the programs being offered, in order to facilitate proper coordination.

- At **DJAMC&H**, the Principal will oversee the implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding.
- At **Vedic Medical Astrology Center, Bangkok, Thailand**, President, will oversee the implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding.




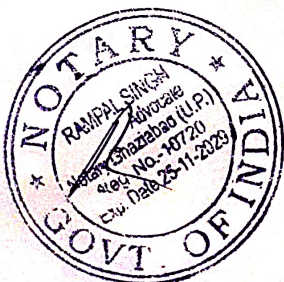

Utilization of research facilities, Joint Research activities

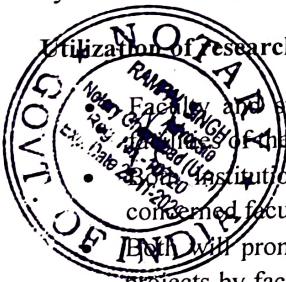
Faculty and students of both institutes will be allowed, with prior permission, to utilize the research facilities of the Institutes by prescribed nominal fee.

(b) Notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) above, the intellectual property rights in respect of any technological development, and any products and services development, carried

out:

(i) Jointly by the parties or research results obtained through the joint activity effort by the Parties, shall be jointly owned by the Parties in accordance with the terms to be mutually agreed upon; and

(ii) Solely and separately by the Party or the research results obtained through the sole and separate effort of the Party, shall be solely owned by the Party concerned.

(iii) The terms and conditions in the execution of the research projects shall be decided on case to case basis.

ARTICLE V: CONFIDENTIALITY

A. Both Parties undertake to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from, or supplied to, the other Party during the period of the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding or any other agreements made pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding:

And the termination of the Understanding shall be on the understanding that students/ faculty who have already enrolled in any of the courses/ research programs as at the time of termination shall remain entitled to complete their respective courses/ research programs and be eligible to appear assessment conducted by the **DJAMC&H** and **Global Ayurveda Academy, USA**, conducted to obtain an award.
