Sir/Madam,

- 1. To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Divya Jyoti Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Niwari Road, Modinagar, Distt. Ghaziabad-201204, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0440) inspection was conducted on 03.04.2025 and 04.04.2025 in Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-

i. Teaching staffs:-

Availability of total teaching staff for UG (BAMS) Course as per the part 1 submitted by the college is Available/Required x100% = 41/45 x100% = 91.11 % (Excluding Excess)

Shortcomings in teaching staff are as under :-

Table with 5 main columns: S. No., Department, Minimum Requirement as per Regulations (for UG upto 100 seats), No. of Existing Teachers (Prof. ssor, Asso. Prof. / Reader, Asst. Prof. / Lecturer, Total, Excess), and Shortcomings of HF and LF. It lists four departments: Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant, Khya Sharir, Dravyaguna Vigyana, and Agad Tantra ayur Vaidhi Vaidyaka.

3. Further, the assessment report was duly placed before the 130th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 03.07.2025 and Board observed that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the concerned acts and regulations but is fulfilling the criteria in accordance with the Board's policy letters issued on 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025. Further, the Board also observed that the college is meeting the notified & requisite criteria for the issuance of the Extended Permission as the college has been permitted for last three consecutive years with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) Course and eligible as per regulation 54(2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024. Accordingly, the Board decided as follows:

a) To issue extended permission in UG with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 as per the provision under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2025-26.

"DECISION"

4. Therefore, Divya Jyoti Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Niwari Road, Modinagar, Distt. Ghaziabad-201204, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0440) is hereby granted with:-

a) Extended permission in UG (BAMS) course with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) for the academic session 2025-26 in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 and;

5. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 55 (2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-

I. Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats in UG Course shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

II. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.

6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

7. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

9. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 55 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-

) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled

- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
 - iv) The compliance of shortcoming mentioned in para- 02.
 - v) Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAAS & HMS. Dated 09/05/2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.
10. The fulfilment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Divya Jyoti Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Niwari Road, Modinagar, Distt. Ghaziabad-201204, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0440)** inspection of your College was conducted on **30.01.2024 & 31.01.2024 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the conditional permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
- Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the 'Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurvedic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016', provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
- Thereafter, the assessment report was placed in the **89th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **10.05.2024**. On careful examination of the assessment report, it is found that your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, due to the following shortcoming:

a) Teaching staffs:-

Availability of teaching staff is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{11}{12} \times 100\% = 91.66\%$ which is not fulfilling the criteria as per Sub Regulation (1) (a) of Regulation 8 and Schedule-V of MSR 2016.

- However, as per regulation 3(3) (a) of MSR, 2016, the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for conditional permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course Hence the Board decided to issue the Conditional Permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
- Therefore, **Conditional Permission is issued to Divya Jyoti Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Niwari Road, Modinagar, Distt. Ghaziabad -201204, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0440) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25** subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements: -
 - The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing PFY and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provisions of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. In view of the above the Central Government constituted the Autonomous Boards with effect from 11th June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provisions of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provisions of NCISM Act 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Divya Jyoti Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Niwari Road, Modinagar, Distt. Ghaziabad-201204, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0440)** inspection of your College was conducted on **01.09.2022 & 02.09.2022 on virtual mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the **Conditional permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23 and relevant regulations thereunder.**
2. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under, and on the basis of Relaxation policy issued by the NCISM dated 16.03.2022. **On examining the same certain deficiencies were observed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM).**
3. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the **18th Board Meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **17.11.2022**. On careful examination of the assessment report it was found that **your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria for issuing of Conditional permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2022-23** and Board decided to provide an opportunity of hearing to your college. Thereafter, an opportunity of hearing was granted to your college on **25.11.2022** to present the case through virtual mode.
4. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, **and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 21st Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 29.11.2022.** Board verified the same and found that the College is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for **grant of Conditional permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23.**
5. In view of above, it has been decided by the **President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine to issue Conditional Permission to Divya Jyoti Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Niwari Road, Modinagar, Distt. Ghaziabad-201204, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0440) for**

intake capacity with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23, subject to following condition:-

- I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100 seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2022-23 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
 - III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/ Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
 7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
 8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2022 **and send a compliance report to get permission for the session 2023-24:**
 - i) all the requirements of Minimum Standard of Infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in to; and
 9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission from the academic session 2023-24.
